1. Describe your favorite Thanksgiving memory. Why was it so special?
2. Read Psalms 107:8-9. According to this passage, what are we supposed to be thankful to God for? (It might help to read these verses in a couple of different versions.)
3. Read Colossians 2:6-7. In the NIV, verse 7 ends with “overflowing with thankfulness.” What does it mean to “overflow”? (This has nothing to do with toilets.)
4. In the story of the ten lepers in Luke 17, we are told that the thankful leper was a Samaritan. Why was this significant?
5. In light of the fact that we are all undeserving of God's grace, how should we respond to others who may seem “undeserving”?
6. As you consider the Advent Conspiracy, what does it mean to you to “worship fully”? To “spend less”? To “give more”? To “love all”?
